A Section 3 worker is someone who:

- 1. Currently fits, or when hired within the past five years* fit, at least one of the following categories as documented
 - A worker that is low or very low income. The worker's *individual* income for the previous or annualized calendar year is below the income limit established by HUD.
 - The worker is employed by a Section 3 business concern.
 - The worker is a Youth Build participant.

A Targeted Section 3 worker means a Section 3 worker who is:

• A worker employed by a Section 3 business concern:

or

A worker who currently fits or when hired fit at least one of the following categories, as documented within the past five years:

- A resident of public housing or Section 8-assisted housing;
- A resident of other public housing projects or Section 8-assisted housing managed by the PHA that is providing the assistance; or
- A Youth Build participant.
